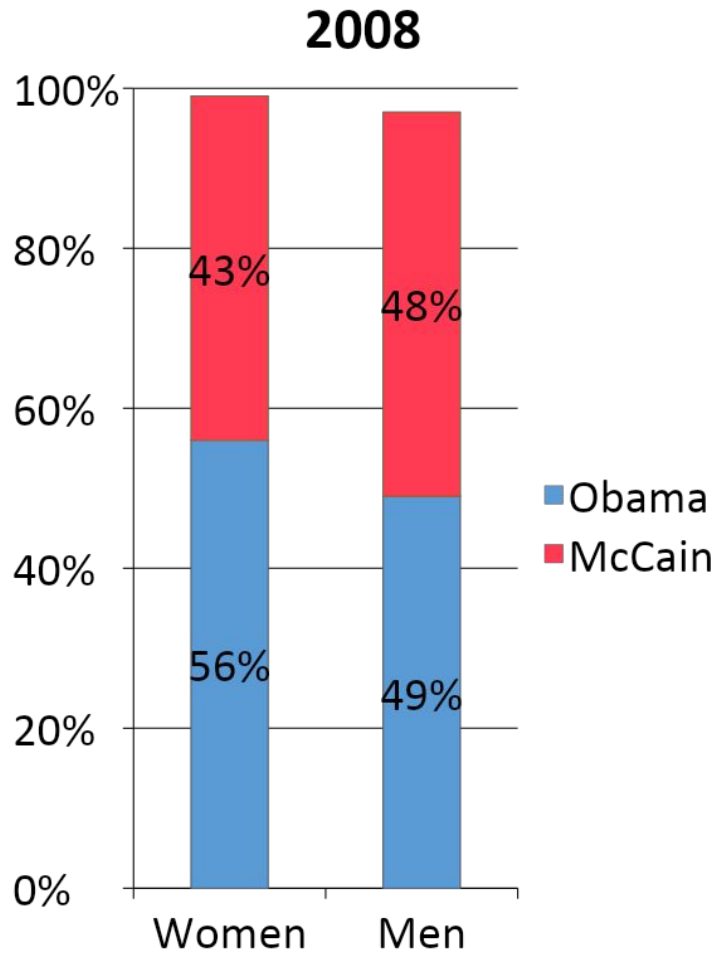


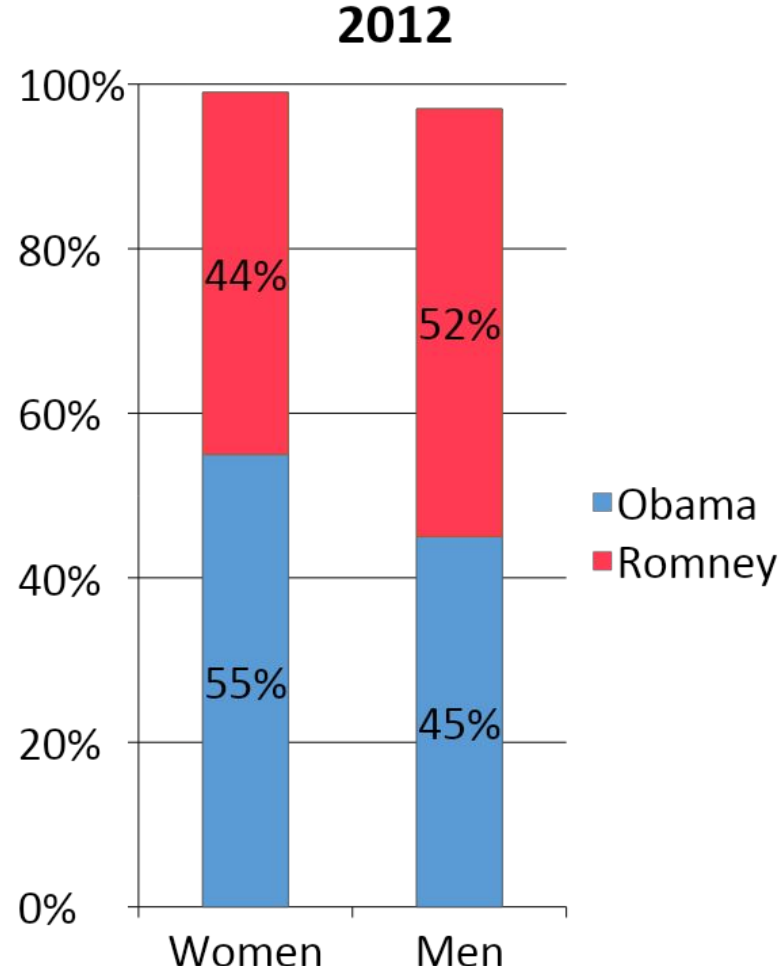
# Conventional wisdom supports gender gap: 2020 VoteCast (Associated Press/NORC)

<b>Gender gap</b>		+ 9%	

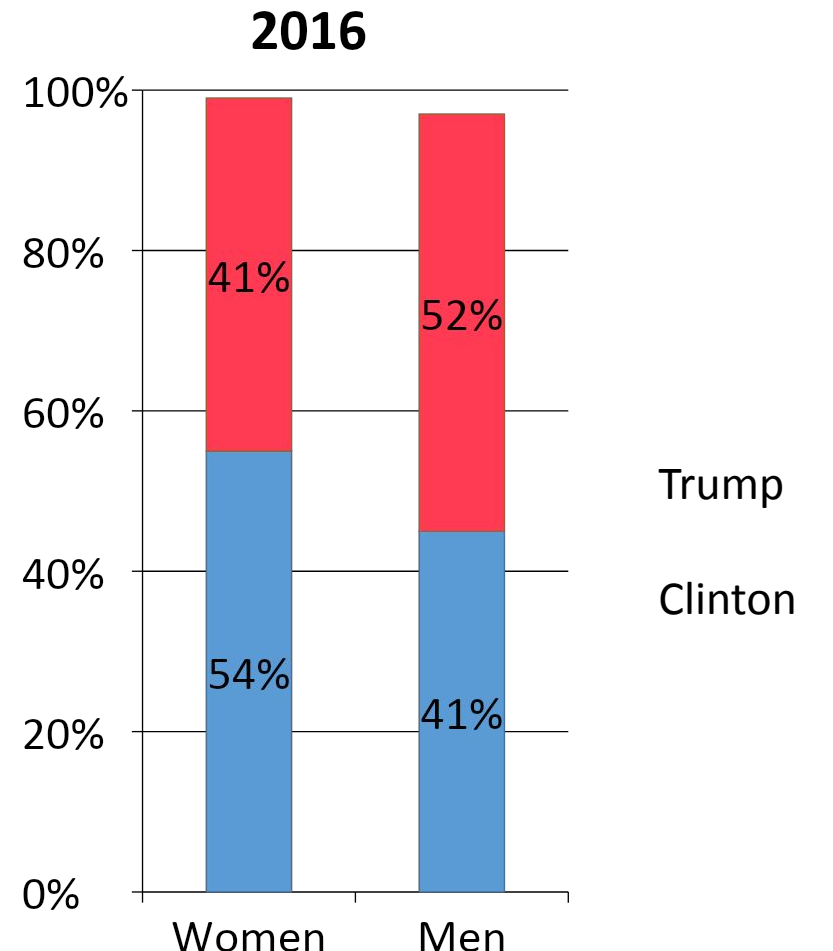
# The Gender Gap in Voting, 2008, 2012, 2016
